Happy fall, everyone! Thought we would give you a quick update as to what is going on over here in Northern Thailand.

Caleb and Rebecca arrived back in Thailand the first part of August as school was about to start and Caleb entered his 11th grade year. Ryan and Tyler stayed back so that Tyler could work longer and then Ryan helped Tyler get settled in Winter Park, CO which is his home for the next 7 months. Rebecca and Caleb were very happy to have Ryan back in Thailand after a long 1 & 1/2 months without him!!!

Not long after Ryan's arrival we welcomed a medical team from Salida, CO. They are here now and we are so thrilled that they made the sacrifice to come all the way over here. The team consists of one Dr. and his wife, three nurses, our hometown pastor and a couple from our church, who are also good friends of ours.



Yesterday the team spent the day at the dorm, first giving the kids general check-ups and then any members of the surrounding community. They held two clinics yesterday, one in the morning and one in the afternoon. In the morning clinic alone they saw over 100 people! Between the two clinics there was a lunch provided at the dorm. The team paid for the food to feed everyone and paid some local help to prepare the food. In the evening Pastor Don shared about Jesus, who He is and what He has done for us.

Also prayers for each of the team members and their health as they eat new foods and are exposed to new and different environments.
