is a Christ-centered organization that provides life affirming and hope inspiring, medical and family resource services and support to women, men, and their families. The Center provides pregnancy tests and limited OB ultrasounds, as well as testing and treatment of sexually transmitted infections. ABC also provides pregnancy and childbirth classes, along with parenting and life skills classes. Material resources (diapers, formula, maternity clothes, etc.) can be earned through Earn While You Learn. ABC provides much needed specialized support through PACE (Post Abortive Care and Education) and REST (Restoring Exploited and Sexually Traumatized).

Josh & Heather Dunn along with daughters, Grace and Hattie, are serving with Biblical Ministries Worldwide in Zacatecas, Mexico. 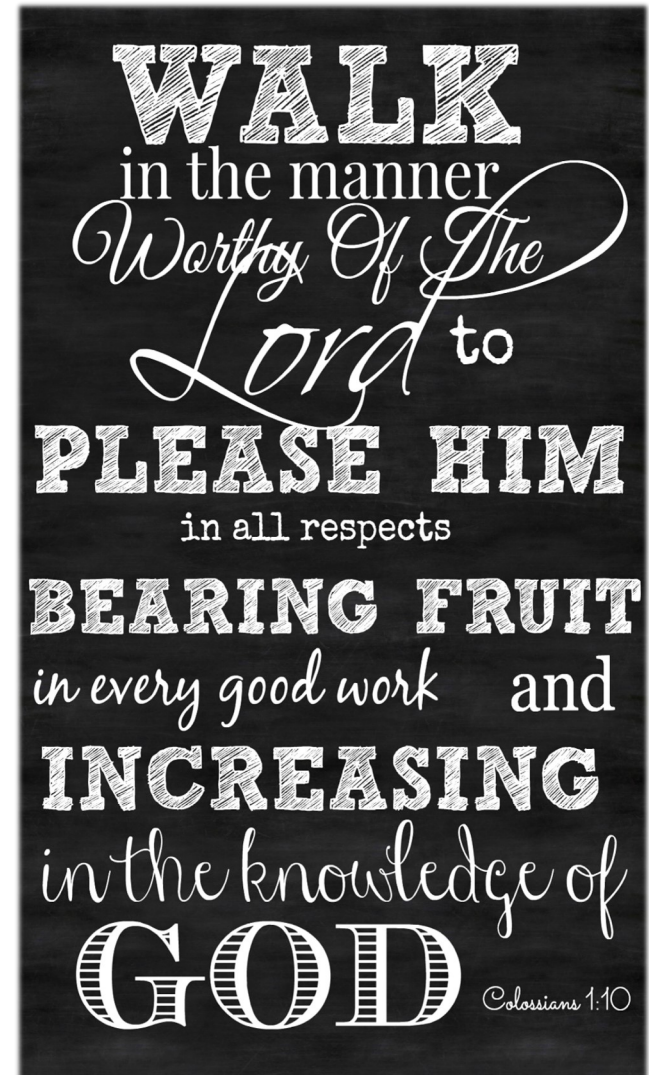
