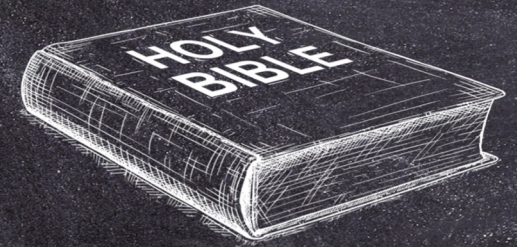
Sometimes the way is lonely
