HIGHLIGHTS**

Larry & Vicki Sharp Larry has been mentoring people in
the missional business space who are serving abroad.
One of the groups he is working with is the Freedom
Business Alliance which seeks to share Christ with the
survivors of human slavery and provides jobs for them so
they are not tempted to return to the trafficking world. He
would love to talk to anyone interested in connecting with

book. Vicki is involved in Ladies' Bible Studies and
community work.

Michael & Nina Schaafsma are serving our Savior
through church planting in Italy. In addition to pastoring
their church in Punto Luce, Michael has also provided
leadership for a church in Bergamo and has begun a
Bible study for a group meeting in Cremona. The
Schaafsma's have also been responsible for the training
courses for an event through the Billy Graham
Association. **Pray** for energy and inspiration to continue
these ministries in an area severely affected by Covid
and resulting lockdowns.

KYKD Radio continues to receive an abundance of
both challenges and blessings from the Lord. This year
the ministry expanded to include a new repeater station
in the Kobuk Valley village of Noorvik, some 500 miles
north of Bethel. Thus KYKD now broadcasts from 8
transmitter sites in western rural Alaska. We also provide
the programming to two small stations owned by Vision
Alaska-KSCM in Scammon Bay and a new station in the
Yukon River village of St. Marys. A huge blessing is the
recent completion of the Yup'ik Audio Bible, taking 6
years of work involving 24 volunteers, making the entire
Word of God available in the spoken native language of
this region. We deeply appreciate the prayers and
financial partnership of SBC. Please pray that we will be
able to wisely build upon God's great blessings and, in
His strength, to meet the challenges which He allows.
