Mike & Kathleen Matthews work with InterAct Ministries. Mike is also involved in church planting in Saskatchewan with Northern Canada Evangelical Mission and in writing resource material for cross-cultural ministry workers.

Tim & Barb Wood, through Sports Outreach Institute in Mexico, run a multifaceted ministry with an approach to sharing the love of Christ in the Costa Chica region of Mexico. The church, La Puerta de Salvacion, represents the hub from which all activities flow. Ministries include Maranatha Soccer, Colegio Admiral R. Corey Brenton School, hospital chaplaincy, youth camps and church planting.
