Tammy Sharp serves missionary kids and their families through Barnabas International, a mission's organization that exists to edify, encourage, enrich and strengthen servants in ministry. Growing up in Brazil as the daughter of Larry and Vicki Sharp gave her insight to the challenges of a cross-cultural upbringing. Tammy loves to build relationships with MKs as they process their transitions and relationship with Christ. She loves to help MKs use their language and skills to advance the great commission.

Larry & Vicki Sharp: Covid has restricted travel, so many trips have been canceled for Larry. However, he has been mentoring several people in the missional business space who are serving abroad. One of the groups he is working with is the Freedom Business Alliance which seeks to share Christ with the survivors of human slavery and provides jobs for them so they are not tempted to return to the trafficking world. He would love to talk to anyone interested in connecting with this issue. He writes weekly blogs (www.ibeventures.com/blog) and is working on a second book. They are settling into their apartment in Everett, WA and Vicki is already involved in Bible studies and community work there.

Michael & Nina Schaafsma are serving our Savior through church planting in Italy. 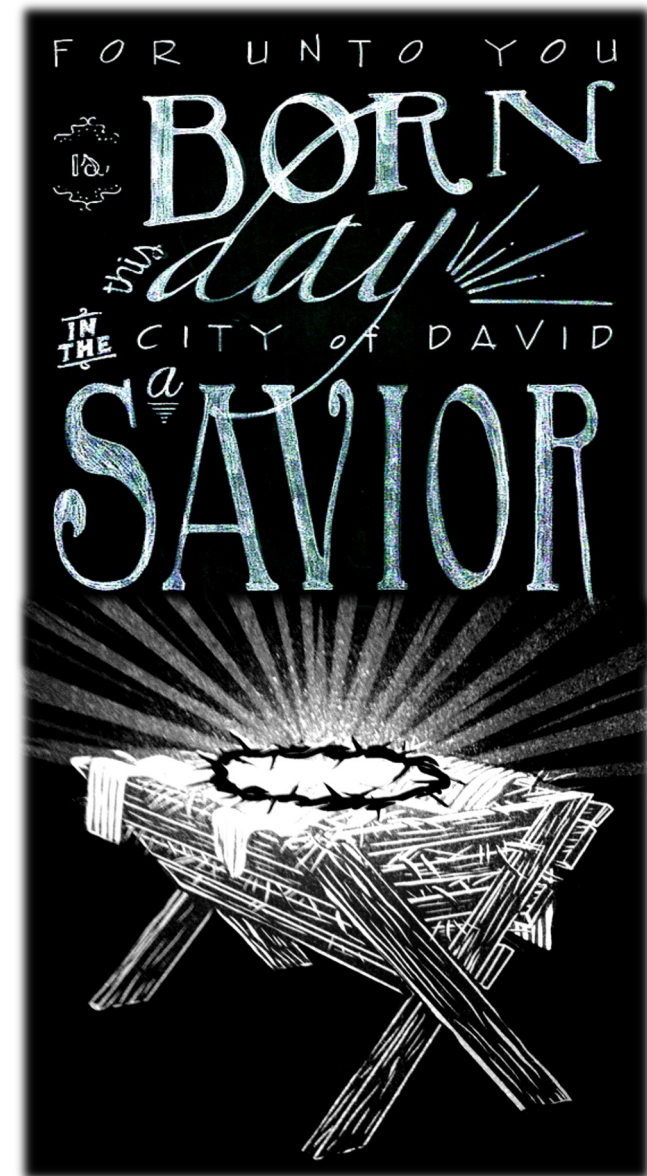
